AUSTIN, TX- A new public charter school facility in South Austin will provide more children in surrounding communities with the opportunity to receive a free, rigorous college preparatory education. Wayside Schools, a PreK3-12 public charter school district, will tomorrow break ground on its new campus. The facility will house Wayside: Altamira Academy, an elementary school serving grades PreK3-5, and Wayside: Sci-Tech Preparatory High School, serving grades 8-12.

To celebrate, Wayside Schools is inviting the Austin-area community to a special groundbreaking ceremony. The ceremony will include light refreshments and a new campus sign reveal. It will also feature district leaders and select students putting the first shovel in the ground.
